Maximum Cost: \$400 per person—covers accommodations, transportation, meals, and materials. Team and individual fundraising will reduce this cost.

Responsibilities: participate in team and individual fundraising; attend mission trip training sessions; prepare to be a responsible mission team member; serve joyfully all or part of the week serving men, women, and children by serving in a local soup kitchen and clothing distribution center, leading children's programming, and assisting in work projects for senior citizens.

Accommodations: Facilities for accommodations are still being determined; however, guys and girls will be staying in separate accommodations chaperoned by FBC leaders

May/June – *Required* team meetings begin—Wednesday, May 26 6:30-8:00 PM • Wednesday, June 2 6:30—8:00 PM

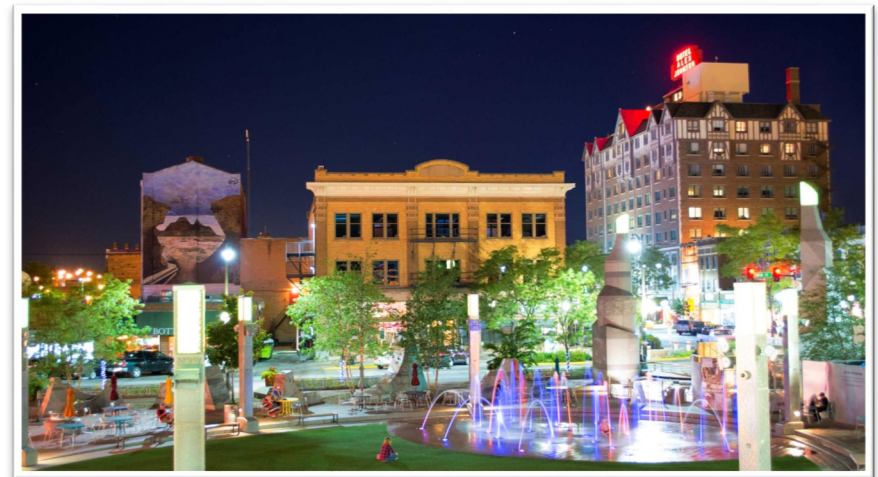
Sunday, June 2 – Full balance due

We will be serving with YouthWorks, an organization FBC has partnered with for many years. In Rapid City, we will partner with several local service agencies and work with children and the elderly. One of the partnerships we will get to work with is Black Hills Works, a progressive and adaptive center for mentally and physically challenged adults in Rapid City. Their center provides job training, paid work, practical life classes and other services. YouthWorks has partnered with this community since 1999, and this will be the first time our teens will get to visit this community on a mission trip.
