 - b. What is the “kingdom that cannot be shaken”?
 - c. After reading this text, how would you define “acceptable worship”?
3. What other Bible texts help you understand “acceptable worship”?
4. In the message, Pastor Mike shared that our aim in worship should be biblical, gospel-rooted, and God-glorifying.
 - a. In what ways do these focuses lead us to “acceptable worship”?
 - b. As you consider your life, is the Holy Spirit directing you to give greater attention to a particular focus (biblical, gospel-rooted, God-glorifying) in order to grow in worship? If yes, which one and in what way(s)?
5. Why is worshipping *together* important?
 - a. How might God grow FBC in our worship together as a church?
 - b. How can you contribute to FBC’s vision of worshipping together?
