Discussion Questions:

- 1. What are some important principles for investing?
- 2. What is your most valuable investment? Why?
- 3. How would you describe the relationship between what we value and how we spend our money? If you can, give an example.
- 4. Read Matthew 6:19-21.
 - a. In what does this passage tell us to invest? Why?
 - b. Does your life align with this passage? If so, how?
- 5. Romans 12 gives us a picture of what it looks like to invest in others through sacrificial service ("living sacrifice"). In what ways have you seen sacrificial service as a blessing in your life (either you sacrificially serving others, or someone sacrificially serving you)?
- 6. In the New Testament, Jesus expands the Old Testament command of the tithe to denote that we are to give faithfully and generously (Malachi 3:10, Luke 12:33, 2 Corinthians 9).
 - a. Why do you think Jesus emphasizes generosity instead of the tithe?
 - b. How might giving faithfully and generously be a step of faith to follow Christ?
- 7. <u>Luke 18:1-8</u> is an example of the value of persistent prayer.

- a. What have you been praying for?
- b. Do you think God is asking you to be persistent in your prayers? Why or why not?
- 8. Is there a way in which God may be asking you to think about investing in the kingdom differently than you had been? If so, how?
