### Discussion Questions

1. How did you come to know Christ as your Savior & Lord? Who invested in you? Who introduced you to Jesus?
2. Read [Matthew 28:16-20](#) and [Acts 1:8](#). What do these passages tell us about going & making disciples?
3. In the Parable of the Lost Sheep, why do you think Jesus says what he does in [Luke 15:7](#)?
4. As with the Parable of the Lost Sheep, what does the Parable of the Lost Coin ([Luke 15:8-10](#)) communicate about the value of intentionally seeking those who are spiritually lost? What keeps us from valuing the spiritually lost in this way?
5. Read the Parable of the Prodigal Son ([Luke 15:11-32](#)).
  - a. In what way(s) do you relate with the Father?
  - b. In what way(s) do you relate with either the young or older brother?
6. Take a few minutes to, personally, make a list of those you know who are spiritually lost.
  - a. Who might God be leading you to have a spiritual conversation with this week?
  - b. How might you go about doing that?
  - c. How would you like those in your life group to pray for you about intentionally going to the spiritually lost?
