- 4. As with the Parable of the Lost Sheep, what does the Parable of the Lost Coin (<u>Luke 15:8-10</u>) communicate about the value of intentionally seeking those who are spiritually lost? What keeps us from valuing the spiritually lost in this way?
- 5. Read the Parable of the Prodigal Son (Luke 15:11-32).
 - a. In what way(s) do you relate with the Father?
 - b. In what way(s) do you relate with either the young or older brother?
- 6. Take a few minutes to, personally, make a list of those you know who are spiritually lost.
 - a. Who might God be leading you to have a spiritual conversation with this week?
 - b. How might you go about doing that?
 - c. How would you like those in your life group to pray for you about intentionally going to the spiritually lost?
