4. In the sermon, Pastor Mike shared about how *identity & purpose, humble honesty, grace & honor, repentance & forgiveness, and faith & trust* are all fostered as the gospel takes firm root in a person's life.
 - a. In what way(s) do these build upon one another?
 - b. Which of these (listed above) seem most evident in your life?
 - c. With which do you tend to lack or struggle the most?
