3. What was the Passover and why did the Jews gather to celebrate it? (see [Exodus 12](#) for context, if needed)
4. Read [Matthew 21:1-11](#) and [Zechariah 9:9](#).
 - a. What correlations do you see between [Zechariah 9:9](#) and [Matthew 21:1-11](#)?
 - b. Why are the connections between these passages significant?
5. In verse 9, the crowds shouted, "Hosanna to the Son of David!" Why do you think they did this?
6. Why is Jesus more than just an ordinary, earthly king?
7. Is there a way in which God might be asking you to increase your trust in Christ as the sovereign and ultimate King over your life?
