 - b. How did Peter respond to Jesus' actions?
 - c. Why didn't Peter need his whole body cleaned?
 - d. How did Judas respond to Jesus' love and service?
 - e. In what way(s) are you tempted to respond like Judas?
 - f. What was the heart of what Jesus said?

3. Read Romans 15:1-7.
 - a. What do these verses communicate about serving one another?

5. What is your next step toward serving someone / others as God is leading you?
