  - a. Which prophecies does John write about in these verses?
  - b. What significance do these prophecies hold in relationship with Jesus' death?

### **Make the Connection**

3. In the sermon, Pastor Mike used the words: *propitiation*, *redemption*, & *reconciliation*.
  - a. What do these words mean? What do these words tell us about what Jesus accomplished at the cross?
  - b. In what ways does Jesus being our propitiation, redemption, & reconciliation offer hope to us?
4. What does it mean to *rest in the finished work of Christ*? What implications does resting in Christ's work have in your everyday life?
5. For what reason / purpose / application is God asking you to trust Christ's finished work on the cross? What does Jesus' work accomplish for you? For God's glory?
