Receive the Word

1. Read Proverbs 31
 - a. What is the bigger picture this passage is pointing us to?
 - b. How is Christ imaged in verse 10-17?
 - c. How is Christ imaged in verses 18-27?
 - d. How is Christ imaged in verses 28-31

Make the Connection

1. As you read this passage/book and realize your inability to live up to its full standard, what kind of response do you have internally? Do you feel pressure to "be better, do better", or do you feel overwhelmed? Or something else?

2. How does seeing Christ as the fulfillment of this passage connect with your
 - a. Identity?
 - b. Purpose?
 - c. Worldview?
